

SECTION 4 Conveyance Information

“Conveyance” means any vehicle used for transportation of hazardous waste on land, water or in the air. For the requirements of the license, the term includes only the cargo carrying portion of a conveyance. (FOR EXAMPLE: IN THE CASE OF A TRACTOR/TRAILER COMBINATION, ONLY THE TRAILER IS REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED.)

Listed below are column (a) through (h) which provide detailed information on each conveyance used to transport hazardous waste. Column (h) refers to the address/location if a conveyance is used for temporary storage of hazardous waste prior to proceeding to the destination point. (Temporary storage means for not more than 48 hours.)
