

Minutes of Meeting #136 Feb 1, 2017

The Maine Public Drinking Water Commission (DWC) held its 136th meeting on Feb 1, 2017 at the Key Bank Building, Augusta Maine.

Present Were:

Members: Jeff LaCasse, Tom Brennan, Brian Richardson, Bob MacKinnon, and Roger Crouse.

Jim Willis, Board Clerk

Time: Jeff called the meeting to order at 9:10 AM

A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Minutes from the last meeting were approved, with the addition of the assignment for Roger researching the ability of the DWP to charge late fees on unpaid AFM bills.

B. RECURRING BUSINESS:

1. ELECTION OF CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR

Elections of Chair and Vice-Chair took place. Jeff LaCasse will remain as Chair and Kathy Moriaty as Vice-Chair.

2. SFY 2017 AFM FEE COLLECTION STATUS

Roger presented the AFM Fee revenue status. The collection rate was at 98.1 percent for a total \$504,420 collected - slightly higher than previous years. Roger stated that spending for the 2017 SFY is higher than anticipated due to changes in indirect expenses. Roger stated that at the May meeting we will have to look at AFM budget and possibly AFM fee increases.

Roger stated that we are not able to charge late fees or interest on overdue AFM because the statute does not provide that authority.

3. LEAD IN DRINKING WATER UPDATES

Roger discussed the progress of lead water testing in schools. So far out of 500 schools 100 schools have sampled. There was discussion at the end of this program what data would be useful to look at.

4. LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Roger provided an overview of LD 40, which would require lead testing in schools, and LD 90, a revision to the charter of the Rumford Water District.

Roger reported that President Trump's Executive Order freezing EPA grants would not affect the DWP.

Bob was going to talk with MRWA to see how the Executive Order would affect MRWA's training and programs.

5. DWP STAFFING UPDATE/VACANCIES

Roger stated that the DWP still has two vacant positions - a Rule Specialist in Augusta and a Public Water System Inspector in Bangor. The 1st round of advertisements resulted in only one qualified candidate for the two positions. The DWP is currently in the process of re-advertising the two positions.

6. OVERVIEW OF DWP TEAMS/POSTIONS

Teresa Trott, Mike Abbott, and Mike Plaziak of the Drinking Water Program provided an overview of their respective teams: Data Management and Program support, Engineering and Water Resources, and Public Water System Inspection.

7. DWC MEMBERSHIP UPDATE-REAPPOINTMENT STATUS

Harvey Chesley is not renewing his seat on the DWC. There was a question on other member's seats and expiration dates. Jim Willis will check on the other members and let members know.




