


# You've heard about meningitis.

Your child may have received a meningitis vaccine, but they are not fully vaccinated against meningococcal meningitis, a deadly bacterial infection, unless they've received **two types of meningitis vaccines.**



**MenACWY vaccine**

**MORE** HAVE RECEIVED

**1<sup>ST</sup> DOSE**  
11-12  
year-olds

**2<sup>ND</sup> DOSE**  
16  
year-olds



**MenB vaccine**

**FEW** HAVE RECEIVED

**1<sup>ST</sup> DOSE**  
16-23  
year-olds\*

**2<sup>ND</sup> DOSE**  
from 1-6  
months after  
1<sup>st</sup> dose\*\*

**Meningococcal meningitis can often occur without warning and can kill in as little as 24 hours.**

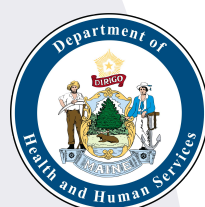
