## Principal fishery: Brook trout

B Lake is shallow with similar temperatures at all depths throughout the summer. Trout seek areas of cool spring influence when lake temperatures become to warm.

Populations of yellow perch, suckers, and minnows are very abundant and reduce trout production by competing for available food and space.

Access to B Lake is via a private road.
