Yellow perch Chain pickerel White sucker Hornpout (bullhead) Pumpkinseed sunfish American eel

Physical Characteristics

Area - 32 acres Average depth - 13 feet Maximum depth - 21 feet Temperatures: Surface - 72⁰F 18 feet - 70⁰F

Principal fishery: Chain pickerel

County Road Lake provides good habitat for chain pickerel and presently supports a good pickerel population. Water temperature becomes warm at all depths during mid-summer months. Yellow perch serve as a major food item for pickerel.

The possibility for brook trout management is highly unlikely due to the lack of public access and the severe competition from the existing species.

The lake is currently open to ice fishing.
