Flinn Pond has a maximum depth of 17 feet, but the average depth is only 4 feet with about equal water temperatures throughout. The northern end of the pond has an abundance of pickerel weed and water lilies; there are scattered patches of pickerel weed at the southern end near the outlet.

The outlet consists of a long deadwater meandering through

a heath bog and has a soft mud bottom.

Although the water temperatures were cool at the time of the survey, habitat conditions are not suitable for coldwater game species. Flinn Pond should be managed for its present populations of chain pickerel and yellow perch.
