

Haywire Pond should be managed for its chain pickerel fishery. The shallow water area contains good habitat for this species, and populations of food fishes are considered adequate.

Haywire Pond is cold below 10 feet in late summer, but the dissolved oxygen concentration below 15 feet is too low to support trout at that time. The pond is potentially fair trout water, and several springs enter along the shore. However, management for trout by chemical reclamation to reduce competing species is not considered feasible. Extensive boggy areas around the shores would probably preclude a complete kill, and no suitable site is available to construct the 3-foot barrier dam on the outlet stream necessary to prevent re-entry of trash fish.

The pond is accessible by a car road in dry weather.
