Physical Characteristics

Area - 3 acres Average depth - 2 feet Maximum depth - 4 feet Temperatures: Surface - 76<sup>0</sup>F 4 feet - 72<sup>0</sup>F

Principal fishery: Brook trout

Isie Lake is a small, shallow pond that has supported a good wild brook trout fishery for many years. Old beaver dams on the outlet influence the water level in the pond, and currently maintain the water level 1-2 feet higher than normal. These dams should not be removed.

The lake bottom is rich organic muck with a moderate growth of pond weeds. One cold tributary and numerous springs around and within the pond provide suitable habitat during hot summer weather when much of the pond has become too warm for trout survival.

Since the pond is less than 10 acres, brook and stream regulations apply To prevent introduction of competitor species, prohibition on use of live bait is recommended.

Access is by gravel roads. Small boats or canoes must be hand-carried down a short path to the pond as no boat launch is available.
