## Suggested Management


Whitehead Lake is shallow with equal temperatures at all depths during the summer months. Several small springs enter along the shoreline. Habitat conditions for brook trout are limited.

The pond supports populations of banded killifish and several species of minnows. Occasional brook trout are taken.

Chemical reclamation is not believed to be justified because of limiting habitat conditions.

No stocking of any kind is recommended.
