

L POND Seven Ponds Twp., Franklin County U.S.G.S. Chain of Ponds, Maine (7½)

Fishes

Brook trout

Minnows Lake chub Blacknose dace

Physical Characteristics

Area - 100 acres

Maximum depth - 14 feet

Principal fishery: Brook trout

L Pond is located southwest of Snow Mountain. The pond has no major inlet, but an outlet flows southwest into Long Pond. Its shoreline is undeveloped.

Water quality in L Pond is well suited for brook trout. A thermocline is present where cool water is available and oxygen is present at all depths during the warm periods. The pond supports a population of wild brook trout. Their growth is good despite competition from minnows. The pond is not stocked.

L Pond is accessible via a trail reached from a private, gated road off Route 27. The pond is open to fly fishing only in the summer and closed to winter fishing. See the lawbook for additional regulations.
