## **Physical Characteristics**

Area - 6 acres Temperatures:

Surface - 70°F

Maximum depth - 24 feet

20 feet - 43°F

Principal fisheries: Brook trout

Ledge Pond is located southwest of Saddleback Mountain. The pond has no major inlet, but an outlet flows east into Eddy Pond. The pond's shoreline is undeveloped.

Water quality in Ledge Pond is suitable for coldwater gamefish; however, the pond lacks any suitable spawning and nursery habitat. Brook trout are stocked annually to provide a fishery. Growth is good with no competition from other fish species.

Ledge Pond is accessible via a foot trail off the Appalachian Trail north of Route 4. The pond is open to fishing in the summer months with the use or possession of live fish as bait being prohibited. It is closed to ice fishing.
