Moxie Pond is located west of Long Pond in the Four Ponds Area south of Rangeley. The pond has no major inlets, but a short outlet flows east into Long Pond. The pond's shoreline is undeveloped.

Water quality in Moxie Pond is marginal for coldwater gamefish. Without available spawning and nursery habitat, annual stockings of brook trout are required to provide for a fishery. A lack of competing species allows for good trout growth.

Moxie Pond is accessible via the Appalachian Trail or over a short foot trail from Long Pond. The pond is open to fly fishing only in the summer months and closed to fishing in the winter. See the lawbook for additional regulations.
