

## Suggested Management

Management of Allen Pond at the present time should emphasize chain pickerel and yellow perch. It is unlikely that stocked brook trout would co-exist satisfactorily with the well-established pickerel and perch. No stocking is recommended.

A brook trout fishery could probably be established by chemical reclamation and subsequent stocking. However, the pond is isolated and the light fishing pressure it receives makes reclamation impractical.
