Suggested Management

Although a few brook trout are reported present in Rocky Pond, a consideration of its shallowness, warm water temperatures, and existing fish populations suggest that management, to be most successful, should be for the warm-water game species. Any attempt to establish a large trout population in such shallow waters with competing bass and yellow perch would certainly result in failure.

In the interest of adjoining salmon and trout waters, special precaution should be taken to avoid the introduction of white perch for its spread into these waters might seriously harm their existing fisheries.
