

## **Physical Characteristics**

Burgess Pond is a small body of water lacking sufficient deep, cold, well-oxygenated water for coldwater sport fish.

At the request of local camp owners, the Department introduced largemouth bass in 1959 and 1964. Fry were captured at a nearby pond and transferred to Burgess Pond. Follow-up sampling revealed a number of different age classes indicating that bass have become a self-sustaining population.
