

Area - 44 acres Temperatures:

Surface - 77°F 26 feet - 52°F

Maximum depth - 30 feet

Principal fisheries: Largemouth bass, chain pickerel

Lily Pond is a shallow warmwater pond with many areas of aquatic vegetation that provides excellent habitat for pickerel and largemouth bass. The bass population consists of a large number of small size fish.

The pond should not be considered for coldwater management due to the large number of competitive species and insufficient oxygen in the deeper water.

Walk in access from the Eight Rod Road.
