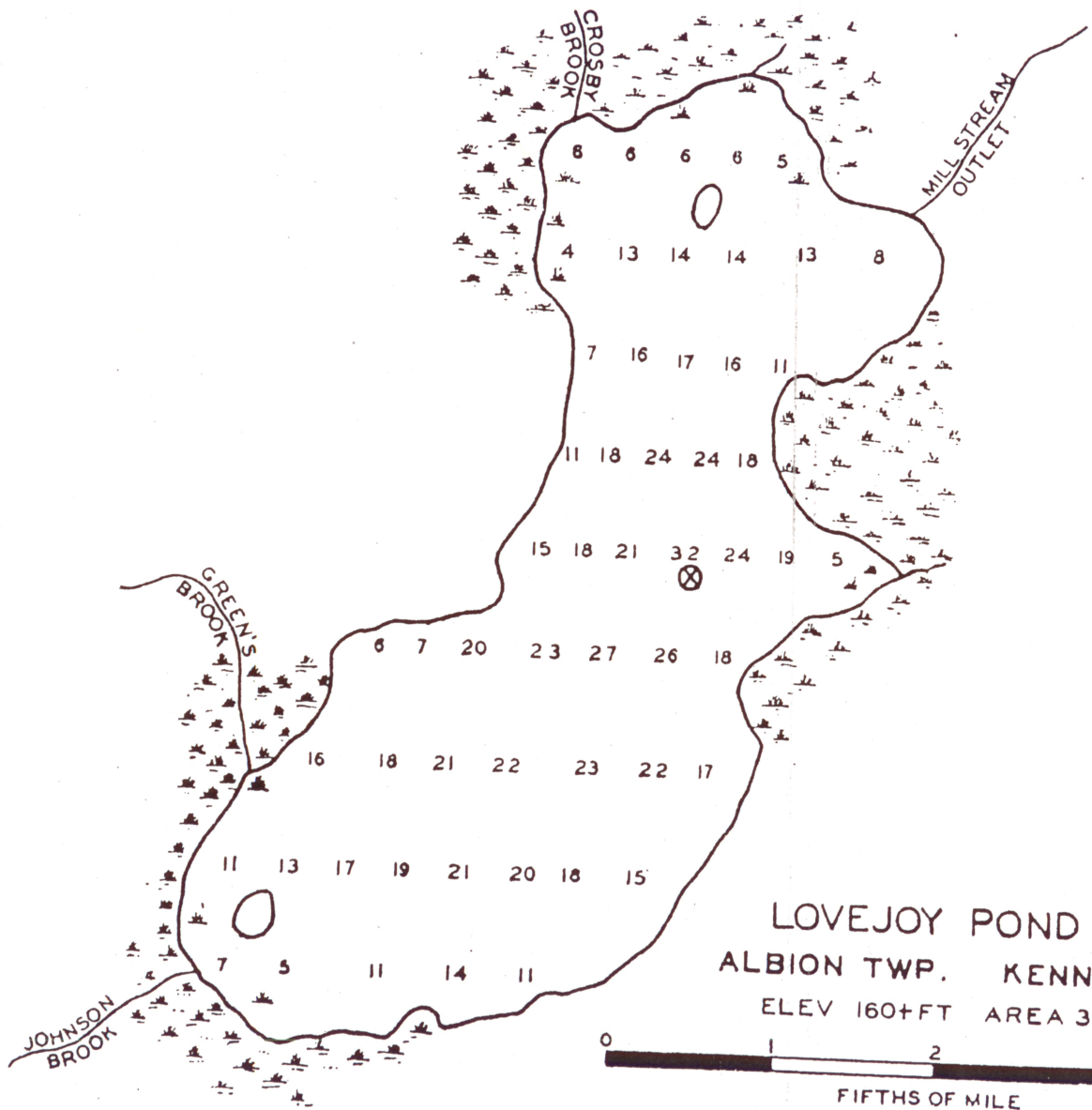

Lovejoy Pond is a shallow warmwater body of water susceptible to algae blooms during the hot summer months. Water quality of this pond mandates management for warmwater sportfish and no coldwater species should be stocked. Anglers can expect good bass and white perch fishing.

A public right of way is provided along the west shore. Access to the pond is also available across undeveloped land at several points.
