Principal Fishery: Largemouth bass, White perch, Chain pickerel

The original survey of Moose Pond in 1957 found it ideally suited for warmwater fishes. The Regional Biologist recommended the introduction of largemouth bass when local anglers expressed sufficient interest. Members of the Parker Pond Association became interested and bass were introduced in 1961. Subsequent surveys have determine that largemouth bass are well established and provide good fishing.

Access to Moose Pond is limited to canoes and small hand carried boats.
