## **Physical Characteristics**

Area - 59 acres Temperatures: Surface - 72°F

Maximum depth - 52 feet 50 feet - 43°F

Principal fisheries: Brown trout, white perch, chain pickerel

Water quality of Savade Pond is considered marginal for coldwater fishery management. Brown trout management has been successful in other central Maine waters with similar water quality, therefore stocking of browns was initiated in 1975. Brown trout are currently stocked annually which maintains an acceptable fishery.
