

## TOLMAN POND Augusta Twp., Kennebec County U.S.G.S. Togus Pond, Maine

Area - 62 acres

Maximum depth - 26 feet

Principal fisheries: Largemouth bass, chain pickerel

Tolman Pond should continued to be managed for warmwater species. The habitat is considered ideal for bass and pickerel. Largemouth bass have become established in Tolman Pond sometime after 1968 when an introduction was made to Dam Pond located downstream.
