Ice Pond is a very shallow weedy pond which provides good largemouth bass habitat. Largemouth bass were first introduced in 1964 at the request of the Lincoln County Fish and Game Association. The pond was again stocked with bass in 1990 after reports of poor fishing.

The pond was completely de-watered during the winter of 1996. Largemouth bass and a forage species should be restocked in Ice pond under the supervision of the Regional Fishery Biologist.

There is no legal public right-of-way to the pond, but the landowners allow access for recreation.
