Past stockings of brown trout have produced some fishing for this species. Insufficient spawning habitat for trout in Knickerbocker Pond necessitates annual stockings to maintain this fishery. The stockings were terminated when public access was loss but were re-instituted when an agreement was reached with Boothbay Harbor Water System to provide access. Public access is over a gravel foot path on the east shore over Boothbay Harbor Water System lands.
