Physical Characteristics

Area - 42 acres

Maximum depth - 18 feet

Temperatures: Surface - 76⁰F 18 feet - 63⁰F

Principal fishery: Smallmouth bass

Weary Pond contains an abundance of warmwater fish habitat. Smallmouth bass are well established in this pond and provide a summer fishery.

The lack of coldwater habitat and the large number of competing species dictate that no trout stocking should occur.

The Weary Pond road runs along the entire west shore creating easy access.
