


Green Pond is located south of Hogan and Whitney Ponds in Oxford, Maine. Although this pond is fairly deep and quite cold near the bottom, the water quality is not well suited for trout management. Water deeper than 15 feet is either too warm or lacking sufficient dissolved oxygen to support a trout fishery.

Largemouth bass have become well established since their illegal introduction in the early 1970's, and continue to provide a good fishery.

Access to Green Pond is restricted to permissive trespass as there is no public access site.
