Smallmouth bass Yellow perch Chain pickerel Minnows Golden shiner Hornpout (bullhead) Pumpkinseed sunfish

## **Physical Characteristics**

Area - 32 acres

Temperatures:

Maximum depth - 41 feet 30 feet - 46°F

Principal fisheries: Smallmouth bass and chain pickerel

Jewett Pond, one of the Five Kezar Ponds, has an oxygen deficiency below 20 feet which precludes the management for coldwater fish species Smallmouth bass, chain pickerel and yellow perch are providing a very good fishery at this time. Chain pickerel in excess of 22 inches are quite common.

There is no public access to Jewett Pond. Access is limited to permissive trespass from the Lovell Road.
