

Late summer water quality is excellent for resident warm water fisheries. However, the pond does not thermally stratify during the summer to provide an area of cold water suitable for trout. The presence of competing and predatory warm water fish further limit opportunities to manage for trout. Mud Pond is best managed for warm water fish.

Angler access is restricted to permissive trespass and there is a need to acquire public access to this pond.
