Physical Characteristics

Area - 32 acres

Maximum depth - 8 feet

Temperatures: Surface - 75°F 8 feet - 72°F

Principal fisheries: Largemouth bass, chain pickerel

Webber Pond is a shallow, weedy pond that lacks the cold water necessary for trout management. Largemouth bass were introduced by this Department in 1989 and are now providing a good fishery. Bass in excess of 3 pounds are not uncommon.

No public access exists to this pond. Currently, access is restricted to permissive trespass along the Plummer Hill Road.
