Little Burnt Pond is located adjacent to the road into the Bangor Water District pumping station on Floods Pond. The road is reached via Route 180, but it is closed to public access.


The pond's shoreline is very rocky. Surrounding woodlands are mixed hardwoods and softwoods. The pond has a mud bottom and is very weedy.
