

## **Physical Characteristics**

Area - 14 acres Temperatures: Surface - 75°F

Maximum depth - 16 feet 15 feet - 62°F

Principal fishery: Chain pickerel

Center Pond is a small, shallow pickerel pond. Brook trout are present in both the inlet and outlet, but the pond itself does not provide suitable year-round water quality. Anglers report catching a few brook trout but this is limited to the early spring.
