Suggested Management

West Garland Pond contains large numbers of warmwater fishes. Chain pickerel are abundant in this small pond and provide a summer and winter fishery.

Successful chemical reclamation of West Garland Pond for trout is not feasible because of the inability to successfully treat the long marshy tributary which enters this pond.

Management of West Garland Pond for pickerel should be continued.

No stocking is recommended.
