

Lowell Lake is a shallow, weedy lake included within the drainage area of the West Branch of the St. Croix River. You cannot drive to the lake at the present time, but roads are reportedly being constructed. The easiest way to find the lake is to go to South Springfield and ask for directions.

Lowell Lake is well suited for the pickerel that now inhabit it, and fish management should emphasize this species.

No stocking is recommended.
