Spring Pond is a small, shallow pond surrounded by a heathspruce bog. Golden shiners are abundant and apparently the only species inhabiting the pond.

It is probable that brook trout never gained access to Spring Pond, since it has no inlets and only an intermittent, dead-end outlet. However, brook trout probably would not survive in numbers sufficient to warrant their introduction. Critically warm temperatures during the summer preclude significant trout survival.

Spring Pond provides a good source of bait and is easily accessible by a car road.
