Principal fishery:

The potential for Dow Pond to be managed for a wild brook trout fishery is compromised by marginal water quality, lack of suitable spawning habitat, and competition from other species. There is a limited fishery for a few wild brook trout.

Dow Pond was stocked with hatchery-reared brook trout for a number of years but the results were less than satisfactory. Brook trout were last stocked in 1980.

The abundance of minnow species has attracted bait catchers to Dow Pond for a number of years. Management for live bait may be the ponds highest potential.

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
