Suggested Management

Hurd Pond has a large area of deep water with very good water quality for cold-water game species and should be managed for lake trout and brook trout.

Some young of the year yellow perch were seined but they appear to be in very poor condition. A scarcity of shallow-water areas will probably prevent this species from becoming a problem.

An old dam apron in the outlet should be removed to facilitate the migration of trout into this area for spawning and to permit the young trout to return to the pond.
