## Suggested Management


First Little Lyford is an excellent small trout pond that will remain productive as long as competition from other fishes does not increase.

The golden shiner, now present in the pond, is competing with the trout for food and space. It is quite likely that this shiner was introduced into the area some years ago.

To prevent further introductions, the use of live fish as bait should always be prohibited. Because the pond is very small and shallow, ice fishing should not be allowed.

The outlet should be kept clear of beaver dams to allow mature trout to spawn there and for young trout to return to the pond.
