Marr Pond is a shallow, productive, warmwater pond located in hilly farming country. Farm woodlots surround most of the pond. Aquatic vegetation is abundant, both above and below the surface of the water.

Fishing pressure is extremely light, composed of neighborhood children who fish for suckers, sunfish, and eels. This shallow weedy pond provides good habitat for pickerel. Chain pickerel should be introduced under the direction of the Regional Fishery Biologist. The pond should be opened to ice fishing.
