Suggested Management

Little Pleasant Pond is renowned for the quality of its brook trout fishery. The pond is an example of a shallow wilderness trout pond where trout are successful because of superior food conditions and little competition. Sufficient spring seepage enables trout to survive during the periods when the main pond becomes too warm.

Natural reproduction in spring areas within the pond is considered adequate to maintain the fishery. No stocking is recommended as long as present fishing pressure and habitat conditions persist.

Maintenance of a five-trout bag limit to distribute the catch is recommended.
