Pretty Pond is a very shallow, muddy-bottomed pond typical of one which is nearing the end of its productive life. The eastern and southern shores have a gravel and boulder bottom but are heavily silted over.

The inlet to Pretty Pond meanders through a cedar swamp and is heavily silted with the exception of scattered patches of sand and gravel. The outlet stream contains good trout spawning areas, but the water level is low and the bottom is partly silted over.

Populations of brook trout are limited by the water quality of the pond and by the heavy competition from yellow perch for food and space.

Because the pond is remote and fishing pressure is light, no stocking is recommended at the present time.
