

Most of Upper Soper Pond is less than 2 feet deep with abundant aquatic vegetation. The main inlet and outlet are deeper than the pond itself. Pond water temperatures become very warm during hot weather, forcing trout to seek inlets or spring areas. Because of these conditions, the pond is inhabited by trout at high water levels or during cool weather periods.

The pond is accessible by boat down the main inlet.
