
Suggested Management

Trout Pond has good water quality for brook trout and should be managed for this species.

A small tributary and the outlet should provide enough spawning facilities to maintain the fishery. It is recommended that stocking be discontinued on a trial basis.

The five-fish daily bag limit with the use or possession of live fish as bait prohibited regulation, now in effect, should be continued.

The tributary and the outlet should be kept free from debris and obstructions to facilitate the migration of spawning fish.
