
Suggested Management

Houghton Pond is a small, shallow warm-water pond ideally suited for largemouth bass.

The introduction of largemouth bass into Houghton should provide an excellent sport fishery. However, access to the pond is presently prevented by property owners who have "posted" the areas surrounding the pond.

No stocking is recommended until anglers are allowed access to the pond. It is suggested that the local fish and game association investigate this situation for a possible solution to the problem.
