Physical Characteristics

Area - 36 acres Temperatures:

Surface - 70°F 20 feet - 53°F

Maximum depth - 23 feet

Principal fisheries: Chain pickerel, black crappie, white perch

An oxygen deficiency occurs during the summer months at Halfmoon Pond thereby limiting the sport fishery to warmwater species. White perch, chain pickerel, and more recently black crappie provide, at times, for some fast fishing. The black crappie migrated into the pond from the Sabasticook River.

Access to Halfmoon Pond is very limited since there is currently no public right-of-way.
