Tobey Pond is located southeast of Cold Stream Mountain. It has a small inlet, which flows in from the north. Its bouldery outlet flows southeast into Tomhegan Stream.

Tobey Pond has good water quality and habitat for brook trout. Oxygen, however, is deficient below twenty-five feet in the summer months. The inlet and shoreline provide suitable spawning conditions and area for a self-sustaining population of brook trout. Growth is below average despite the lack of competitor species. Tobey Pond is not stocked.

The shoreline of Tobey Pond is undeveloped. Access is via gravel logging roads off Rt. 201. Surveyed - August, 1991 Maine Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Funded in part by the Federal Aid in Restoration Act under Federal Project F-28-P L4078D
