Suggested Management

Tomhegan is a shallow bog-type pond. The water quality is suitable for brook trout, but competition from large populations of suckers and minnows is keeping the trout population at a low level. No stocking of hatchery fish is recommended.

A small driving dam, at the outlet of the pond, should be removed, or a fishway should be provided to allow the free movement of migrating fishes.
