Thistle Pond is a shallow, mud-bottom pond with an abundance of aquatic plants. These plants provide plenty of cover and ideal feeding areas for the chain pickerel population.

Low oxygen in the deeper water and competition from the numerous warmwater fishes make Thistle Pond unsuitable for coldwater species.
