Knight Pond is a shallow pond that is best suited for warmwater fish species such as bass, perch and pickerel. This pond is too warm during the summer months to support coldwater fish species, but catchable-size brook trout are stocked each spring to provide a seasonal fishery.

Access is limited to walk-in or carry in across private property with landowner permission.
