Lone Pond was chemically reclaimed in 1939 to remove competing species and permit intensive management for brook trout. The pond was stocked annually with brook trout and provided a very good fishery for many years. Stocking was discontinued in 1989 due to a lack of suitable public access. It is a priority of this Department to locate suitable public access to Lone Pond. Until then, no stocking will take place.
