Principal fisheries: Largemouth bass, and chain pickerel

The MDIFW introduced largemouth bass to this shallow, weedy, and productive pond in 1962. An abundance of golden shiners and sunfish provide a good food base for both chain pickerel and largemouth bass.

There is no known public boat access to Swan Pond, however, an existing tote road off the "H Road" likely provides access across private property. Public access accommodations are very tentative and could be terminated in the future. There is a need to secure long-term public access to this pond.
