INTRODUCTION

This document is a Consent Agreement regarding Glenn M. Bangs' license to practice practical nursing in the State of Maine. The parties enter into this Agreement pursuant to 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003(5)(A-1)(1), § 8003(5)(B) and 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A(1-A)(A). The parties to this Consent Agreement are Glenn M. Bangs ("Licensee"), Maine State Board of Nursing ("Board") and the Office of the Attorney General, State of Maine. An informal conference was held on November 17, 2005. The parties reached this Agreement on the basis of information submitted by Maine Veterans' Homes located in South Paris, Maine, dated October 29, 2004 and March 17, 2005. Exhibit 1.

FACTS

- 1. Glenn M. Bangs has been a licensed practical nurse licensed to practice in Maine since 2002.
- 2. Glenn M. Bangs admits to the multiple medication errors and counseling regarding the medication errors stated in Exhibit 1.
- 3. The Board has no facts evidencing patient harm related to the medication errors.

AGREEMENT

- 4. Glenn M. Bangs agrees and understands that his conduct in the above-stated facts constitutes grounds for discipline under Title 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A(2)(F), (2)(H) and Chapter 4.1.A.6 of the Rules and Regulations of the Maine State Board of Nursing. Glenn M. Bangs is hereby **WARNED** for unprofessional conduct because he failed to follow policies and procedures in the practice situation designed to safeguard the patient.
- 5. Glenn M. Bangs understands that this Consent Agreement imposes discipline regarding his license to practice practical nursing in the State of Maine. Mr. Bangs understands that he does not have to execute this Consent Agreement and that he has the right to consult with an attorney before entering into this Consent Agreement.
- 6. Glenn M. Bangs affirms that he executes this Consent Agreement of his own free will.
- 7. Modification of this Consent Agreement must be in writing and signed by all the parties.
