Dear Mr. Boucher:


This is to notify you that pursuant to 32 M.R.S.A. Section 2105-A(2)(A), (2)(F), (2)(G) and (2)(H) and 5 M.R.S.A. Section 10004(1), the Board met on September 19, 1990, and voted to revoke your license to practice as a professional registered nurse in the State of Maine.

The above action was based upon your statements to state police, Togus V.A. hospital police and Detective Susan Randall of the Department of Attorney General regarding the theft of personal property from patients and staff and the diversion of drugs from various hospitals you have worked at.

The evidence gathered by these agencies and your statements admitting to most of the allegations resulted in your intensive supervision probation being revoked on September 10, 1990. The Court imposed a sentence as a result of the revocation. Based on all of the above, the Board revoked your nursing license pursuant to 5 M.R.S.A. Section 10004(1).
